Our staff is a small, dedicated group of professional journalists, editors, and videographers, both Chinese and American, with vast experience working both in China and the United States.





Interns will be involved closely with the ChinaFile team and integral to the preparation of content for daily publication on the site. The internship will include preparation of materials both on short notice to meet publication deadlines, and for longer-term, more in-depth projects. This intern should have a strong interest and familiarity with Chinese culture and current affairs – including Chinese social media, the environment, the arts, social issues, politics, international relations, or other contemporary issues. From this internship, you will gain a strong network of China contacts, language practice in English or Mandarin Chinese, and the experience of being a dynamic participant in the production of a new and growing website.

- Assist with the maintenance of the website by preparing pieces for publication, help with social media outreach, and help with the maintenance of collections, as well as provide support for day-to-day website operations.
