Lesson Plan 2: Education for a Global World

LESSON TITLE: Education for a Global World

DURATION: Approximately 60 minutes

OBJECTIVES

- Research information about international trade.
- Consider educational experiences (including the study of a world language) to prepare for jobs in an international market.

SUMMARY OF TASKS/ACTIONS

Students work independently to research and complete a worksheet. The worksheet requires students to conduct research on international trade and languages spoken in other countries, as well as reflect on their experiences and educational opportunities.
