Emma (Hanying) Wu has been a bi-lingual writer, reporter and editor for over 10 years. She helped launch China's state TV's first overseas bureau in Washington D.C. in 2008. Over the years, she has been a reporter and presenter for China Central TV's DC Bureau. She has covered issues from all aspects of the American society: 2008 Presidential Election, Financial Crisis (2008 to 2009), China-US relations(1on1 interview with then-Secretary of State Hillary Clinton during then-Chinese President Hu Jintao's state visit to US), etc.

She has anchored CCTV 4 International Channel's morning news program "the latest from the Americas." The daily 10-minute news program covered news and feature stories from North and South America.

Emma Wu has been covering major events in culture and arts, especially Hollywood and China. She has interviewed prominent news-makers such as Michelle Kwan, Joseph Nye, Quincy Jones, James Cameron, Mike Medavoy, Lang Lang, Yo-Yo Ma and etc. Emma Wu's also passionate about facilitating educational, cultural and business exchanges between China and the west, with her wide-ranging contacts.

Before she came to work in the United States, Emma Wu was a line-producer and news editor in CCTV English channel and oversaw daily news-production of China's state TV's English news service.
