### Announcement:

For nearly 60 years, Asia Society has been the leading educational organization dedicated to promoting mutual understanding and strengthening partnerships among peoples, leaders, and institutions of Asia and the United States in a global context. Across the fields of arts, business, culture, education, and policy, the Society provides insight, generates ideas, and promotes collaboration to address present challenges and create a shared future.

The Corporate Engagement team is seeking a college or graduate student intern to become acquainted with the activities pertaining to Global Talent Initiatives and Corporate Membership. Global Talent Initiatives activities include the planning of the 2018 Diversity Leadership Forum, a high end training and development conference for Asian Pacific American corporate leaders. The intern will also get involved with the 2018 Asian Pacific Americans Corporate Survey Report, a research report that highlights the opportunities and challenges of promoting Asian Pacific Americans into senior leadership positions.

Corporate Membership activities will include learning how to draft membership renewals and acknowledgments, event planning and logistics, and prospect research. Additionally they will learn how to produce a weekly *Corporate Connections* e-newsletter to send to all corporate member executives and employees.

The intern will receive training and hands-on experience in the following areas: researching global diversity and inclusion trends; conference development; coordinating webinars; managing contact database and registration software; managing social media platforms; and the logistics related to all of the Corporate Engagement team's areas of work. Also occasional after-hours (1-2 times per month) for experiencing how to implement Asia Society events/ programs from start to conclusion
