## **About Asia Society Texas Center**

Global Mission with a Local Purpose

Founded in 1979, Asia Society Texas Center engages the diversity of Houston through a broad range of enriching programs and events within the pillars of arts and culture, business and policy, exhibitions, and education and outreach. As one of the nation's most ethnically diverse cities, Houston is home to a rapidly growing Asian-American population. Through a multi-disciplinary approach, Asia Society educates the greater community on relevant ideas and issues of our time, preparing future generations for stronger understanding and interaction between east and west.

### Night Market

Influenced by the vibrant street markets found throughout Asia, *Night Market* engages Houston's diversity in a free, family-friendly celebration of Asian culture, art and food. For this event, the Center is transformed into a vibrant marketplace rich with local Asian foods, handcrafted goods, and traditional and contemporary arts. There will be live performances, artisanal craft demonstrations, and hands-on activities enriching the cultural experience.

The last Night Market, held in September 2015, attracted a diverse crowd of almost 2,000 visitors. Food trucks and vendors dotted the lawn and street in front of the Center selling everything from Texas-raised Kobe beef to made-to-order Chinese sausage and egg crepes. The Community Cloth, a microenterprise initiative that fosters marketing opportunities for refugee female artisans in Houston, served as one of the 25 vendors. Night Market's guests were also treated to an animal visit by Houston Zoo, ikebana demonstrations by Ikebana International, and Khmer and Korean lessons by Masterword Services. The highlight of the night was the opening of Asia Society's exhibition Drawn from Nature, featuring contemporary works by four artists from Japan, Korea, Tibet, and Cambodia.

In addition to the food trucks, educational and cultural activities, this year's Night Market will provide attendees with free admission to the two exhibitions on-view - 3DPRK and In the Wake. Guests are encouraged to explore the art galleries with docent's on-hand to offer a deeper knowledge of the exhibition. 3DPRK aims to humanize North Korea by mixing 3D technology with portraiture of its locals. While In the Wake explores the photographic response to the Great East Japan Earthquake of 2011 that struck Northeast Japan, destroying virtually everything in its path and irrevocably damaging the Fukushima nuclear power plant. These exhibitions greatly increase our guests understanding of historical and current matters significant to Asia.

Combined with these thought provoking exhibitions and fun and educational activities, *Night Market 2016* will help Asia Society fulfill its mission to educate and enrich the diversity of the Houston community.


