

# HEALTHY CITY | RESILIENT CITY

## Forum Overview

A majority of the world's population now live in cities. The Asia-Pacific region is home to some of the world's largest megacities, which are major drivers of economic growth. But in many of these cities, greenhouse gas emissions are growing rapidly and there is acute vulnerability to climate change and extreme weather events. Meeting basic human needs - including clean air and water, affordable and adequate housing, and sufficient green space - are challenges.

Building more sustainable, resilient, and livable cities can have enormous quality of life and health benefits for urban dwellers, as well as the planet as a whole. For example, by providing a range of mobility options, cities can reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve air quality, mitigate the urban heat island effect, and increase opportunities for physical activity. By leveraging green infrastructure, cities can enhance water quality and reduce vulnerability to flooding. Compact communities with strong social connections can enable residents to better prepare for, cope with, and recover from major natural disasters and other catastrophes.

The linkages between land use, health, livability and resilience form the basis for the Pacific Cities Sustainability Initiative Forum, "Healthy City | Resilient City." This forum, presented jointly by the Asia Society and Urban Land Institute, brings together a cross-sector group of urban practitioners from across the Asia-Pacific region to share ideas and insights and set the stage for action.

The goal of the 2015 PCSI Forum is to explore and refine the attributes of a healthy, resilient, and sustainable city. The forum seeks to catalyze new innovations and relationships that will lead to positive outcomes for cities throughout the Asia-Pacific region and the world.

Fortunately, approaches that recognize the interconnections between resilience, health, urban form and planning processes can contribute to the triple bottom line: social, environmental, and economic performance. By prioritizing the well-being of people, nature, and the built environment, cities can become more sustainable, livable, resilient and healthy.



# 健康城市|韧力城市

## 论坛简介

当前全球大多数的人口居住在城市。世界上一些特大城市集中在环太平洋地区，这成为了当地经济增长的主要驱动力。与此同时，这些城市由于温室气体排放量的快速增长而在面临气候变化和极端天气时显得日益脆弱。人类生活的基本需求包括清洁的空气、水以及可负担的和足够的住房，而保留大片的绿地则成了城市所要面临的巨大挑战。

建设更加可持续的、有韧力的、宜居的城市可以为城市居民带来较高的生活质量和健康效益，同时也有益于整个生态环境的发展。例如，通过一系列灵活机动的措施，可以减少城市的温室气体排放，改善空气质量，缓解城市热岛效应并增加居民户外运动的机会。通过利用绿色的基础设施，可以提高城市水质并减少洪水灾害。而具有紧密社会联系的小型社区可以使居民们更好的准备和应对较大的自然灾害和其他灾难并快速从灾难中恢复过来。

土地利用、健康、宜居性和韧力之间的联系将是第三届环太平洋城市可持续发展倡议（PCSI）国际论坛“健康城市|韧力城市”的主要议题。该论坛由亚洲协会和城市土地学会联合主办，将汇集来自环太平洋地区各行业的城市建设者们共同分享看法和见解，并建立联合行动的平台。

2015年PCSI论坛的目标是探索和完善城市健康、有韧力和可持续的关键特点和要素。本次论坛将寻求促进环太平洋地区和世界其他城市不断创新及繁荣发展的关键与联系。

幸运的是，如果能很好的把握城市韧力、健康、形态和规划之间的相互联系就会有益于改善城市发展中的社会、环境和经济表现三个基本方面。将人类福祉、自然和建筑环境优先考虑到城市建设中就会使城市向更持续、宜居、有韧力和健康的方向发展。

# FORUM SPEAKERS AND DISCUSSION LEADERS



**Lanchun Bian** is an Associate Professor of the School of Architecture, Tsinghua University. His research and teaching interest focuses on urban design and urban conservation. Mr. Lanchun has spearheaded multiple design projects in Beijing; most recently the Beijing Fujing Historic District Conservation Plan (2009-2010). He is also Deputy Director the Urban Design and Urban Conservation Academic Committee of Beijing City Planning Institute.



**Uwe Brandes** is founding Executive Director of the Master's Program in Urban and Regional Planning at Georgetown University. His previous positions include Senior Vice President at ULI and Director of Capital Projects and Planning for the Anacostia Waterfront Corporation. Mr. Brandes has lectured widely on urban design and public space topics. He serves on the board of several non-profit organizations, including the Landscape Architecture Foundation and EcoDistricts.



**Nicholas Brooke** is the Chairman of Professional Property Services Limited in Hong Kong. He is also a Justice of the Peace, and a former Deputy Chairman of the Hong Kong Town Planning Board and a former member of the Hong Kong Housing Authority. He also sits on the Board of the Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation, the Standing Commission on Civil Service Salaries and Conditions of Service and is a member of the Hong Kong Harbour-front Enhancement Committee, and is the Chairman of the Hong Kong Coalition of Service Industries.



**Deland Chan** is a Lecturer in Urban Studies at Stanford University and a faculty adviser for the Urban Sustainability concentration. She teaches project-based classes where students collaborate with organizations to support their sustainability efforts. Deland also teaches courses on human-centered urbanization that focus on the intersection of design thinking, peacemaking, and community building in urban environments. Ms. Chan has professional planning experience leading transportation planning and land use projects in San Francisco.



**Youngmin Chang** is the Director of Programs and develops overall programs at CityNet which is an association of 135 cities, organizations and private companies. Before she joined CityNet, she had worked for ten years as the Associate Director of a non-profit organization, International Action, in Washington, D.C., which she co-founded and serves as a board member. She was honored to be selected as one of the 40 Under 40 professionals on urban land use by the Urban Land Institute in 2014. Rudd remains engaged in a range of international challenges including global economic management, climate change, and sustainable development.



**Prof. Serge Salat** is an architect, designer, urban planner and urban economist. A global scientist in urban morphology studies and sciences of complexity, he is a leading expert in spatial planning, land use, urban energy, urban resilience, TOD economics and urban finance.
