Dr. Pratapaditya Pal is an art historian of South and South East Asian and Himalayan Art. Dr. Pal has done pioneering research on the arts of Tibet, Nepal, and India; been the curator of numerous major exhibitions; and authored more than sixty publications. He received a doctorate

in fine arts and history from the University of Calcutta and a second PhD from the University of Cambridge. He has served as a curator at The Museum of Fine Arts, Boston, and the Los Angeles County Museum of Art; research fellow at the Norton Simon Museum, Pasadena; and visiting curator at the Art Institute of Chicago. He has taught at several universities including Harvard; University of Southern California; University of California, Santa Barbara; and University of California, Irvine. He was also the general editor of Marg Publishing for seventeen years.
