Bidou Yamaguchi (b. 1970, Fukuoka, Japan) has been a Noh mask creator affiliated with the Hōshō School of Noh in Tokyo since 1998. The sculpture *Ippei's Sister, Osan* represents his belief that Sharaku's *ōkuobi-e*, or large-scale bust portraits hold their own against western portrait art.
