
In a concise and interactive format that accommodates a demanding work schedule, the program provides valuable opportunities to engage with industry experts, business leaders, world-class professors, and your peers.

Program Overview

Five thematic pillars form the foundation of the program, while several additional elements round off the program's curriculum.

All sessions are designed to be highly interactive: active participation and contribution to the discussion is encouraged and expected. Participants are required to prepare for each session; pre-reading materials are provided in advance.



In More Detail

Strategic Empathy

Strategic empathy means looking at issues from the perspective of others and understanding the motivations behind their actions. Understanding a country's present requires understanding its past: history plays a crucial role and is this session's central focus.

Geopolitics

With the U.S. increasingly focusing on internal policy issues instead of foreign policy, other global powers, such as China and India, are on the rise. In this session, we discuss important geopolitical shifts and how their ripple effects are being felt by businesses and politics worldwide.

Economics

The Asia-Pacific region is anticipated to be the key long-term growth engine. However, shifting alliances and geopolitical tensions are causing fluctuations in trade relations, supply chains, and financial markets. In this session, we assess the global economic outlook in light of this uncertain environment.

Innovation & Technology

Asia is one of the fastest-growing regions in terms of innovation and technological advancement. In this session, we examine how countries in Asia are leveraging this advantage to drive economic growth and sustainable development.

Connecting the Dots

In this final session, we bring together key insights from previous sessions and connect the dots. We discuss your main takeaways, and reflect how the knowledge you've gained through the program will shape your decision-making going forward.

Your learning journey starts here! Get to know your peers and Asia Society Switzerland. Kick-off the conversation on Asia and how it relates to you and your business – and to that of your peers.
