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Measures for the Recommended List of National Market Enterprises for Outsourcing Projects (Trial)

Chapter I Aims and Purposes

Article 1 In order to meet the requirements of the development situation of outsourced projects, maintain the order of national market operation, strengthen in-sid supervision and ex post evaluation of outsourced projects, encourage and support enterprises with good performance and good credit to expand their business, in accordance with the Regulations on the Administration of Outsourced Projects and other laws and regulations and This system is formulated for the relevant norms of the externally contracted engineering industry.

Article 2 The purpose of these Measures is to put forward a recommended list of enterprises in other markets in the country through a comprehensive evaluation of the implementation of projects by industry enterprises abroad, and publish it to a certain range in orderly and healthy development of relevant national market business.

Article 3 The national market that implements the enterprise recommendation list system is mainly determined by the national market characteristics, development potential and business risks of the contractors' association based on the implementation and participation in project investment (negotiation) of Chinese-funded enterprises abroad in the past three years.

Chapter II Conditions for inclusion in the recommended list

Article 4 Enterprises included in the recommended list shall meet the following conditions:

(1) In the past three years of business activities, strictly abide by relevant policies, laws and regulations and business ethics, have no violations, discipline violations, commercial bribery and other

bad behaviors, and no bad records in government departments, financial institutions, industry organizations, etc.;

(II) In the past three years of business activities, we have been honest and trustworthy, management standards, actively fulfilled social responsibilities, and paid attention to project sustainability and territorial management. The projects undertaken have no major construction periods, quality, management problems and safety accidents, and no major losses;

(3) Actively safeguard national interests, industry interests and image, abide by relevant industry regulations, and obey the business coordination of contractors' associations and embassies abroad;

(iv) Projects under construction or completed (including master and subcontracting) not less than \$10 million in other markets in the country, and go through the relevant filing procedures in accordance with the relevant provisions;

(5) The performance of enterprises in other markets in the country is good, and local owners, communities and government agencies, embassies abroad, business (participation) offices, Chinesefunded enterprise associations and other institutions are well evaluated.

Article 5 The enterprise on the recommendation list shall be a member of the Contractor's Association and actively perform its membership obligations, including but not limited to filing projects with the Chamber of Commerce in accordance with regulations.

Chapter III Working Procedures

Article 6 The recommended list of national market enterprises shall be implemented in the survival of the fittest and adjusted dynamically. The overall review adjustment is made at the beginning of each year and determined after consideration by the meeting of the presidents of the contractors.

Article 7 Enterprises that intend to apply for inclusion in the recommendation list may submit a written application to the contractor and submit relevant supporting materials, including:

(I) Letter of application. Including the brief introduction and contact information of the enterprise, the country to apply for inclusion in the recommendation list and the main reasons (name and content of the project, amount and source of funds, owner name, progress, etc.), the commitment to the authenticity of the materials provided and the legal liabilities arising therefrom.

(II) Relevant performance certification materials.

Article 8 After accepting the application, the contractor will verify the relevant information, initially check whether it meets the requirements for inclusion in the recommendation list, and give feedback to the applicant enterprise.

Article 9 After determining the national market with the recommendation list system at the beginning of each year, the contractor will submit a preliminary recommendation list for enterprises in other countries according to the application, business statistics, filing information, industry credit records, project supervision and ex post evaluation.

Article 10 If an enterprise has any objection to the preliminary recommendation list, it may appeal or apply to the Coordinating Committee of the Contractors' Association, which shall review it by the Coordinating Committee.

Article 11 The contractor will further solicit the opinions of the president units, the competent departments of the domestic government, the business (participation) offices of embassies abroad, and relevant financial institutions on the preliminary list of recommended enterprises, and on this basis, submit it to the coordination committee for review.

Article 12 The recommended list of enterprises reviewed and approved by the coordinating committee will be submitted to the meeting of presidents of the contractors for consideration and determination.

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Article 13 The contractor will publish other national markets in Chinese and English to relevant domestic government departments, financial institutions, foreign embassies' business (participation offices), foreign embassies (consulates), project owners, international multilateral development financial institutions, international organizations and other relevant institutions in Chinese and English according to the needs of work. Business referral list.

Article 14 If an enterprise that has been included in the recommendation list is punished for unfair competition or no longer meets the conditions for inclusion in the recommendation list, it will be adjusted in accordance with the working procedures.

Article 15 For enterprises that have not been included in the recommended list, the contractor will establish a guidance mechanism to assist enterprises to familiarize themselves with the overseas market, encourage and support enterprises to cooperate with the listed enterprises by means of subcontracting, consortia, etc., and gradually improve the performance and strength of the enterprise. When the requirements are met, they can submit it to the contractor. Application.

Article 16 For enterprises that are not included in the recommendation list to track and promote projects with strong professionalism, the contractor may make special recommendations according to the professional strength and performance of the enterprise and on the basis of complying with the relevant coordination and recommendation principles, regardless of the list.

Chapter 4 Application of the Recommended List

Article 17 When carrying out relevant project coordination, recommending enterprises to participate in intergovernmental cooperation projects or projects using Chinese funds, contractors will refer to this system and give priority to supporting the enterprises on the recommendation list on the basis of following the relevant coordination provisions of the Chamber of Commerce.

Article 18 The contractor will, at the request of the enterprise, issue letters of support and credit certificates for financial institutions, project owners and relevant parties according to the recommendation list. For relevant requirements, please refer to the Interim Measures for Handling Credit Certification and Letters of Recommendation of Member Enterprises.

Article 19 For member enterprises that are not included in the market recommendation list, if the enterprise has corresponding strength and performance and meets the classification standards and relevant coordination recommendation principles, the contractor may make special recommendations to the owner at the request of the enterprise.

Chapter V Supplementary Provisions

Article 20 These Measures shall be formulated by the Contractors' Association's Industry Rules Committee and shall be responsible for interpretation.

Article 21 These Measures shall be implemented after being adopted by the third boards of directors of the seventh session of the Contractors' Meeting on November 30, 2017. The Regulations on the Coordination of National Market Volumes for Foreign Contracted Projects (Trial) and the Detailed Rules for the Coordination of the Market for Specific Overseas Contracted Projects (Trial) shall be repealed from the date of implementation of this system.

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
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
