

## ASIA SOCIETY TEXAS CULTURE CAMPS HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES

- Campers will be screened each morning with temperature checks.
- All Asia Society Texas staff and volunteers will be screened daily in accordance with the Asia Society Texas safety policy.
- Masks are optional for campers.
- Access to camp spaces will be limited to Asia Society Texas staff and campers. All
  drop-off and pick-up for campers will occur curbside at the building entrance to help
  maintain the integrity of our camp spaces.
- Camp games and activities will occur in camp-designated spaces. Campers will visit the art gallery when the building is closed to other visitors.
- Camp spaces will undergo a thorough daily cleaning, with supplies sanitized as they are used.

Culture CampS policies are informed by current recommendations from local, state, and federal health officials, agencies, and authorities, including Harris County and the CDC. As such, these policies may shift or change.



## **CAMP CANCELATION POLICY**

Due to the high demand for camp spaces and the limited number of spots available, all sales are considered final.

Patrons who provide a written notice of cancelation to Jennifer Kapral, Director of Education and Outreach, at **JKapral@asiasociety.org** on or before May 1, 2023, will receive a 50 percent refund of camp registration fees. No refunds will be issued after this date, including students who miss all or partial programs due to illness.

Asia Society Texas reserves the right to cancel any program due to minimal enrollment, inclement weather, or unforeseen circumstances, in which case a full refund will be issued. Cancelations are official upon receipt of confirmation from Asia Society Texas staff.
