Vietnam is a long country and is 127,881 square miles. It has a very tropical climate and a diverse topography with lowlands to rolling hills, even dense forests.



Deltas

Vietnam has two very important deltas. The first being the Red River Delta which is located in northern Vietnam. The second being the Mekong Delta in southern Vietnam.






