<u>February at Asia Society:</u> TWO Weekends of Lunar New Year Celebrations, Plus MSNBC Anchor Ali Velshi's Return and the Final Weeks of *Ayomi Yoshida* Exhibition



HOUSTON, TX — Asia Society Texas Center (ASTC) invites Houstonians to celebrate Lunar New Year and the Year of the Pig with festivities over two weekends in early February.

The celebration kicks off on Friday, February 8, with **Enchanting Puppetry Traditions of Henan**, a performance presented in partnership with the Consulate General of the People's Republic of China in Houston. Folk legends and historical tales come alive via traditional *zhangtou* (rod-based) puppetry by the Puppet Troupe of the Henan Opera and Dance Theater.

The festivities continue on Saturday, February 9, with a free **Family Day: Lunar New Year** at ASTC. Families will enjoy an array of arts and crafts, hands-on kids' activities, and food inspired by Lunar New Year traditions across Asia. Lion dancers of Shaolin Kung Fu Academy in Houston and two ticketed performances by Huaxing Arts Group round out a joyous celebration of the Year of the Pig.

Shoppers can look forward to **Asia Society's Lunar New Year at The Galleria** on Sunday, February 10, and Saturday and Sunday, February 16 and 17. Korean Arts Group, Huaxing Arts Group, and Shaolin Academy Lion Dancers will present traditional and contemporary Asian performances on Level One near Nordstrom. ASTC will also offer a selection of arts and crafts activities and games, all free of charge, to Galleria visitors.
