

Module 4: Assessing Global STEM Project Based Learning Activity Guide



Before moving to the next module, complete these activities:

- 1. Complete the assessment section of the project planning template.
- 2. Review the Asia Society Global Leadership Performance Outcomes, I Can Statements, and Rubrics to assess growth in global leadership skills.
- 3. Access the Project Management Institute Education Foundation (PMIEF) <u>Teacher Toolkit</u> to review resources on assessing student performance in project management. In order to download the PMIEF Toolkit for Teachers, following these steps:
 - Create a free account with PMIEF to access the Teacher Toolkit materials using the link on the top of the page.
 - Select the PM Terminology version of the Toolkit for download.
 - Agree to the terms and conditions.
 - Download the full Toolkit, which includes five downloadable folders: Preface, Initiating, Planning, Executing, and Closing. Each folder has four components - Teacher Guide, Student Project Plan, Slide Deck, and an Appendix with additional resources and activities.
 - The Preface folder contains an introduction to the toolkit, background information on project management, and assessment tools.
- 3. Review sample authentic assessment tools. Good starting places are the <u>California Adult Literacy Professional Development Project</u> and the National Education Association.
- 4. Review self-assessment and peer-assessment tools. <u>Here</u> is a short video about student self-assessment and peer-assessment.
- 5. Be sure to check the Asia Society Global CTE <u>Toolkit</u> for free tools and resources.
